\$100 will pay for:

4 **transportation for patients** to and from treatment through our *Volunteer Driver Program*. Patients who use this program report they have less anxiety and can concentrate on beating their cancer.

8 **Patient Care Kits** which contain practical items and information to help newly diagnosed patients cope.

\$120 will pay for:

2 **support sessions** for a newly diagnosed Northwest Territory cancer patient from a *NWT Patient Navigator Health Care Professional*.

6 **consultations** with our *Cancer Information Service*. This service is offered free of charge to patients, their families, the general public and healthcare professionals. Trained specialists answer questions about all types of cancer, treatment, support programs – anything relating to cancer.



\$150

will pay for two **CancerConnection** matches.

CancerConnection is a telephone support program that matches people with trained volunteers who have experienced cancer either themselves or as a caregiver, providing invaluable information and understanding.

\$250

will support a patient for **1 month** in a clinical trial.

These trials offer access to new treatment, and help scientists answer important questions about cancer.



\$350 will cover the costs of **3 Inspiring Hope Support Group Series meetings**.

These support groups bring together people who are facing a cancer diagnosis so they can benefit from the support of professionals, cancer survivors and those facing a similar diagnosis.
